ABOUT THE INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

We offer seven levels of English courses, beginning through advanced. The program offers a comprehensive curriculum of core classes, electives, and extracurricular programming. Each session is nine weeks long with 18-24 hours of instruction per week. On average, students complete one level per term. Placement test determines starting level.
